



Center for Inclusive Child Care: Recertification Registration Form

In 2017, the Center for Inclusive Child Care is offering a number of self-paced professional development opportunities for CICC trainers to become recertified to continue to train the following two curricula:

- *Children and Challenging Behavior: Making Inclusion Work*
- *The Six Keys: Strategies for Promoting Mental Health in Early Childhood Settings*

How do I know if I need to recertify?

CICC certified trainer's courses expire every 5 years from the month/year in which they were certified in that course. If you are uncertain, please check your individual CICC training record which can be found by logging in with your password at <http://www.inclusivechildcare.org/resourcesWeb2/login.cfm>

Why is the CICC requiring recertification?

There are several reasons for recertification of trainers. First, some of the curricula CICC trainers use is out of print and required reprinting to update current research and best practice. Because of the changing nature of some topics, such as autism, training content needs to reflect those changes. Second, it is valuable to be in a community of professionals such as yourselves sharing ideas and resources about trainings. Finally, the CICC is working in tandem with other professional development organizations to ensure quality opportunities for trainers and providers.

How do I recertify?

The recertification process will be self-paced using the online CICC Learning Center Self Study courses and TOT Center message boards. Trainers will be able to renew the courses at their own convenience within a 30-day time limit.

What will renewal/recertification cost?

The cost for taking the self-paced recertification course is \$40.00. Participants in *Challenging Behavior: Making Inclusion Work* will need to purchase the newest edition of Volume 1 used for the course at a cost of \$16.00. Participants recertifying in *The Six Keys: Strategies for Promoting Children's Mental Health* can use their original book and training curriculum.
